





FSH Role

Foodscale Hub has been overall responsible for setting up MPowerBIO Capacity Building Programme—along with designing and overseeing the Business Support Programme for biobased SMEs. From customer needs to crowdfunding, from PR to pitching and demystifying the funding landscape, Foodscale Hub delivered 8 courses (out of 25 in total) - some of which were rated with the highest score by SMEs as the most helpful ones.

Coming next in 2022...

In 2022, MPowerBIO is launching its second cycle of Cluster Capacity Building and SME Business Support Programmes. After their completion, there will be a number of regional events where high-growth SMEs will have the opportunity to connect with experts from the industry, experts, advisors, investors and more. Top SMEs will be invited to the MPowerBIO Final event for a chance to win additional services, all aimed towards reducing their time-to-market and boosting their investment readiness.

FSH Role

Foodscale Hub leads one of eleven Sustainable Innovation Pilots - SIP #9. The focus of this Pilot is on facilitating the transfer of surplus food from farmers, retailers and other agribusiness stakeholders to socially disadvantaged groups, by aligning logistics and processes. In March 2021, Foodscale Hub launched the FoodSHare Platform, helping producers and companies prevent food waste in a socially responsible way. Within less than a year, the Platform became fully operational, covering two Balkan countries - Serbia and North Macedonia.

Coming next in 2022...

In 2022, we will focus on attracting new donors to the Platform, as well as on increasing regular, ongoing donations. At Foodscale Hub, our ultimate goal is to build stable and lasting relations with producers and companies and position the Platform as a reference point for surplus food redistribution and donation.

FSH Role

Foodscale Hub is heavily involved in Open Call management, overseeing the financial management of third parties and supporting the regional demonstrators in the launch of their Open Calls. These Calls aim to attract innovative SMEs and independent professionals who will provide their services through the dRural platform. To ensure that the process runs smoothly, Foodscale Hub has started working on an initial set of documents and guidelines that applicants will have to follow during the application process.

Coming next in 2022...

Foodscale Hub acts as the treasurer in Open Calls planned for October 2022. In total, we will distribute 1,200,000€ equity-free to 96 European SMEs. They will provide their services and solutions via the dRural platform in four Regional Demonstrators—Spain, Sweden, Croatia and the Netherlands. An additional amount of 960,000€ will be distributed in 2024 in mirror regions to replicate the success and best practices from Regional Demonstrators.

Foodscale Hub is in charge of communication, ecosystem building and exploitation activities. We are creating strategic, bold and immersive campaigns that help bring the affordable, high quality autonomous solution to market at scale. Then again, we are building a collaborative RaaS business model that creates more value for both our partners and target customers.

Coming next in 2022...

This spring Robs4Crops is launching its large-scale pilots in 4 countries. In parallel, Foodscale Hub will roll out the second phase of Business Modelling and Exploitation activities, the focus being on market validation, growth strategies and IPR issues.

Moreover, Foodscale Hub is heavily involved in the development of collaborative business business models that will accelerate market growth and positioning of the CoRoSect system.

Coming next in 2022...

In 2022, CoRoSect will launch its large-scale pilots in Italian Cricket Farm, Nasekono, Invertapro and Entocycle. We will feature a variety of immersive demo events and videos, allowing potential users to get a taste of what is to come and evaluate the system. We will also deep dive into business modelling and exploitation.

This spring, BioeconomyVentures is launching its first Open Call for bioeconomy startups, SMEs and scale-ups. We are looking for bio-based innovators with product- market fit solutions and scalable products. Top innovators will then be invited to enter a unique Investment Readiness programme to work on their business strategy and build an attractive investment case.




